ARBITRATION/MEDIATION AND ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE EXPERIENCE

During the time of service on the Kentucky Commission on Human Rights Mr. Karem conducted most of the public hearings for that agency. These were essentially administrative law hearings.
